Field Trip Info: Please note: All parents who plan to drive or chaperone field trips must have a background check through the Diocese and provide proof of insurance **each year**. All others must complete the forms that are available in the offices. **Please do this now to eliminate confusion.** We cannot process the background checks in fewer than ten days. **Last minute arrangements will not be an option.** The required insurance information must be provided each school year with a copy of your driver's license.

Handling Payments: Please remember all money submitted to the school should be in an envelope labeled with the student's name, grade, and payment purpose, i.e. cafeteria, daycare, fieldtrip, pictures, etc. Check our documents file on our website for labels you can complete, print, and fasten to an envelope to help us ensure proper credit is given. Elementary parents are asked to use the envelopes provided to submit money.
