Personal Property

Each student is responsible for his/her own school supplies. On the first day of school, please arrive with the “essentials”—pens, pencils, paper, etc. Each teacher will instruct the students regarding necessary supplies for his/her coursework. They will receive this information on the first day of school.

At-home Printers: Each student at RCMHS is expected to have access to a printer at home. Without a printer at home, students regularly arrive at school scrambling to find a printer to use, often relying on individual teachers’ personal printers and leaving them late for class. While there will be some printing capacity at school, this should **not** be considered a regular option for printing assignments. All copies (whether printed on a school printer or on a teacher’s personal printer) will cost \$.15 per page. Therefore, RCMHS *strongly recommends* that students have a printer to use at home so that students will arrive at school prepared to turn in all assignments on time.

Community Property

Please arrive on the first day of school with all of your “community property” so that these items may be distributed to the teachers. When you arrive at school on the first day, please place all community property items on the designated tables. There is no need to put the student’s name on these supplies.

Community property for **all students** to bring the first day of school:

- 2 packs of printer paper
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2-3 boxes of Kleenex.
- 1 pack of Hall’s cough drops

Additionally, students in each grade are asked to bring the following designated items:

7th grade: one can Lysol and one jar of Clorox wipes

8th grade: two 2-packs of Expo dry-erase markers and one jar of Clorox wipes

9th Grade: one bottle of Tums.

10th grade: Students in grade 10 with a last name beginning with A-L one bottle of Tylenol; Last name beginning with M-Z bring one bottle of Ibuprofen.

11th grade: one bottle of instant hand sanitizer and one jar of Clorox wipes.

12th grade: one bottle of instant hand sanitizer and one jar of Clorox wipes.
