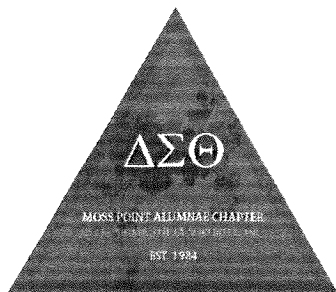

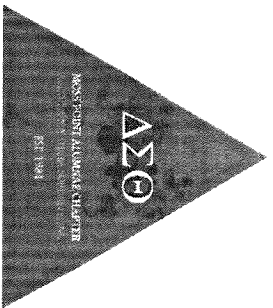

All Applicants must:

- Be a 2020 graduating senior
- Have a 3.0 grade point average
- Have an ACT score of 18 or above, or an SAT score of 860 or above.
- Provide an official copy of their high school transcript with their GPA computed on the transcript.

All Application Packets must include:

- Complete MPA application and sign
 - Verification From submitted by Counselor
 - Student resume' (include paid and unpaid work, school activities and community involvement
 - Copy of official transcript with current class schedule and GPA on the transcript
 - Two letters of recommendation (typed on letterhead)
- One letter from a school official

Incomplete application packet will not be considered. Applications should be postmarked by the deadline, March 23, 2020 via postal mail only. No Application will be accepted after the Deadline.
