The Pascagoula Negro/Carver High School Alumni Association is pleased that you are applying for its scholarship.

To be considered for the scholarship, the following items are required to complete the application process:

1. Completed application typed or handwritten legibly in ink
2. Official transcript mailed in a sealed envelope from school's registrar's office
3. Recent photo (individual 3x5) attached to application
4. Two (2) letters of recommendation mailed with the application. One from a school official, one from a community leader
5. Typewritten essay, signed and dated (**minimum of 200, maximum of 500 words**)
6. Listed name of Alumni member applying or name of sponsoring alumni member in application, must have paid or pay annual membership dues for the previous year and for the current fiscal year.
7. Indicate on the application if you are related to a PNCHS graduate and provide the name of the relative
8. All applications must be postmarked by May 3, 2021

Verification of enrollment for the academic school year in a full-time college/university is required before disbursements are awarded.

**NOTE: Only completed scholarship application packages will be considered.**

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## **SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**

1. The Pascagoula Negro/Carver High School Alumni Association offers scholarships to alumni members and other applicants sponsored by a member who may be pursuing either an Associate Degree, Bachelor of Arts or Science Degree, or other Advanced Degrees.
2. The Pascagoula Negro/Carver High School Alumni Association will award scholarships with the number of awards given based upon the funds available for that year.
3. Recipients must provide verification of acceptance to an accredited junior/senior college or university.
4. Scholarship awards will be based on the applicant's grade point average, ACT scores, and involvement in school and community activities.
5. Scholarship payments shall be made directly to the scholarship recipient(s). Verification of enrollment for the academic school year in a full -time college/university is required before each disbursement. Disbursements are made in two installments.
