Eligibility Guidelines

1. A resident of Jackson County, Mississippi and enrolled at Gautier, Pascagoula, Moss Point or Resurrection High School.
2. Have obtained a “B” average GPA.
3. Have obtained a minimum score of 21 on the ACT.
4. Exhibit financial need.

Scholarship Award Guidelines

1. Scholarships will be for a one-time issuance only.
2. Funds will be used for educational expenses only.
3. Funds will be payable to the college or university of choice.

Judging Criteria

The Junior Auxiliary of Pascagoula-Moss Point Scholarship Committee will review and rate the applications based on the following criteria:

1. Application is to be completed by applicant.
2. Application must be typed or neatly printed.
3. Attach the following to completed application:
 - a. Two (2) character reference letters (i.e. teachers, minister, club sponsor)
 - b. Picture (wallet size attached to resume)
 - c. Copy of high school transcript
 - d. Copy of ACT/SAT scores
 - e. Resume'
