78th ANNUAL CARNIVAL BALL “The Splendor of Versailles”

One of the biggest events and oldest traditions of the year at RCS is our annual Carnival Ball. We are looking forward to another great ball and hope that you will consider entering your child. Our theme this year is “The Splendor of Versailles.”

Currently each participant will be guaranteed two tickets, apart from the High Court. The two-ticket guarantee is the same as every other year; however, we will be able to sell tickets at the door. We will also provide a live stream of the Ball for those who cannot attend.

*REMINDERS FOR FUNDRAISING MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

There is now a fundraising minimum of \$2000 to be eligible for a Lady in Waiting position. The Grand Duke and Duchess position will require a \$4000 fundraising minimum to be eligible. King and Queen-\$5000 fundraising minimum. If there is not a high school couple who raises the minimum, the position will not be awarded this year.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CONTEST ENTRY:

1. Complete the attached form and return to school no later than Friday, January 6, 2023. You must check either “pay now” and be billed through FACTS or “pay with fund raising” so we will know how to classify the entry form. **If you choose “pay with fundraising” and do not turn in your fees by February 3, 2023, it will automatically be billed through FACTS with a due date of February 8, 2023.**
2. **PK3-6th Grade:** \$150.00 per person* (\$300.00 per couple)
3. **7th-8th Grade:** \$150.00 per person* (\$300.00 per couple)
4. **9th – 12th Grade:** \$150.00 per person* (\$300.00 per couple)
5. **The entry fee will not be used to purchase a full-page ad. You must pay for ads separately from the entry fee.**
6. Boys may ask girls or girls may ask boys to run as couples. Couples may consist of mixed grade level; however, they may go up or down **one grade level only (PK – 8); two grade levels (9-12)**. Siblings may escort each other with multiple year separation. The position in the court will be listed under the girl’s grade. (6th grade participants may not go up a grade level; they have to stay within the elementary school) * **Boys are allowed to escort more than one girl ***
7. All high school ball participants (grades 9-12) will be allowed to work on decorations on Friday, February 10, 2023. They will be excused from classes only to work on the Ball, with the exception of any tests being given. Students must take tests that day, if applicable.

Turning in Money:

1. All money turned in **MUST** be in the form of checks made payable to RCS. (NO cash or coins are accepted).
2. You may turn in money at any time. Please be sure to place in an envelope and mark it clearly with the name of the child it should be credited to. All money amounts will be kept confidential.
3. All money turned in on Friday, February 3, 2023, **MUST** be turned in to the **HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS** in the cafeteria (conference room) by 1:00 PM (no exceptions).
4. A record of all money submitted will be kept private and only revealed to the parent of that student.
5. **Ad money may be turned in on or before Friday, February 3, 2023, BUT the print-ready ads and forms must be turned in by Monday, January 23, 2023, at 12pm, no exceptions.**

Tickets:

- Your complimentary tickets will accompany your child's announcement of position. You will receive (2) per family *(with the exception of the high court). Additional tickets will be available for purchase at the door.

Seating:

- High Court will receive priority seating. Seats will be marked with the High Court member's names. All other participants will be seated in the unmarked seats and bleachers.

Dress Code:

Girls: The Queen is the only participant allowed to wear a white gown.

Only the King and Queen wear crowns.

PK-2nd Grade girls may wear tea-length dresses.

GRADES 3- 12 MUST wear FLOOR length gowns and be age appropriate.

ALL MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL GIRLS MUST HAVE THEIR GOWNS APPROVED BY MRS. SISSON. NO EXCEPTIONS.

NO nude or sheer bodices, which give the illusion of plunging necklines. No nude/sheer mesh on the sides of the dress.

NO DRESSES with thigh high slits or high/low hemlines (short front and long backs.) NO EXCEPTIONS.

Gowns should be modest and have no visible cleavage, no bare midriff, or clinging silhouettes.

High school girls must wear white or black full length (to elbow) gloves. Little girls in the High Court (train bearer, crown bearer, flower girl) may wear wrist-length white gloves.

FUNDRAISING

FUNDRAISING INFORMATION:

If you plan to do any fundraisers that require use of the school facilities, you must clear this with the principal. Also, there are fundraising information sheets attached to packet that must be completed and approved by the principal. This will allow you to distribute information to students through school handouts and will keep the Carnival Ball Committee informed of special fundraising activities. The fundraiser form is attached to the end of this packet.

There will be no limit on the number of "football squares" being sold. Multiple couples may sell squares for the same game.

***Any fundraisers that involve a raffle of any kind must be drawn and announced the night of the ball OR you may do a live stream of the drawing and post to Facebook to notify the winner.**

MATCHING GRANTS:

There are several companies within our community (Chevron, etc...) that offer employee donation match grants. Employees may use matching grants for the amount THEY ALONE donate. The matching grant can be applied to the participant of their choice **as long as ALL paperwork has been turned in. Please check with your company/institution to have them specify their specific requirements/procedure for this process as there have been changes made regarding this process with some companies. This will avoid any unforeseen problems or mix-ups at the last minute when money is turned in and placement in court is awarded. If you do not have the confirmation of donation in hand to turn in, the Match cannot be counted toward the participant's total. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU CHECK WITH YOUR COMPANY/INSTITUTION TO VERIFY REQUIREMENTS, SO AS TO AVOID A DELAY IN RECEIVING CREDIT FOR THE DONATION.**

AD SALES:

We need everyone to help us make sure the ads are print ready when they are turned in. If not, we cannot guarantee they will be included. We do not have enough time to recreate ads that are not ready before we go to print the final product. Please remember the following:

1. Ad must be computer generated. Photos should be scanned in OR copies attached that will not be returned.
2. Canva is a free, easy-to-use app that can assist you in designing your ad. Please be sure to download the ad as a PNG, PDF or JPEG and email to: RCScarnivalball@gmail.com
3. If you sell an ad for ½ page but turn in a business card, we will only print the business card “as is”. Please make sure they submit the card in proper size for the ad.
4. No hand-printed or “pencil” ads. They will not show up when printed.
5. **The entry fee will not be used to purchase a full-page ad. You must pay for ads separately from the entry fee.**

Each student will receive full credit for each ad sold. These can be individual or business ads. Please use the attached form for submitting ad sales. A letter is also provided to give to all participating businesses. This letter will serve as their tax deduction form. Please make them aware of this when you make the sale.

All ads must be “Print Ready” and submitted with money by **Monday, January 23, 2023, at 12pm (PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS BEFORE FINAL MONEY IS DUE!) If your ad is received after **January 23, 2023**, we cannot guarantee that it will run in the program.**

POSITIONS OPEN FOR COMPETITION (Elementary School)

Crowns will be awarded to King and Queen Positions ONLY... No other crowns or tiaras are to be worn

Little girls in the High Court (train bearer, crown bearer, flower girl, gift bearer) may wear wrist-length white gloves.

Pre-K, K and 1st -

- Crown Bearers – 1 couple
 - Students compete as a couple from grades Pre-K-1. The couple bringing in the highest amount of money will be crown bearers to the King and Queen. Crown Bearer girl will receive a halo of flowers to wear in her hair.
- Flower Girl and Court Herald – 2 couples
 - The two couples bringing in the second and third highest amounts of money will be flower girls to the Queen and Heralds to the King. The Flower Girls will receive halos of flowers to wear in their hair.
- Princess/Prince
 - The couple bringing in the next highest amount of money in each grade will be the prince/princess of that grade. Princesses will receive flower to carry.
- Maids and Escorts
 - All other participants will be maids and escorts

Grade 2 -

- Gift Bearers – 1 couple
 - The couple raising the most money in 2nd grade will be Gift Bearers to the King and Queen.
- Princess/Prince
 - The couple bringing in the next highest amount of money in each grade will be the prince/princess of that grade. Princesses will receive flowers to carry.
- Maids and Escorts
 - All other participants will be maids and escorts

Grades 3-5 -

- Train Bearers
 - Students compete as a couple from grades 3-5. The two couples in the group raising the most money will be trainbearers to the King and Queen. (Highest fundraiser will serve as Trainbearers to the Queen, 2nd Highest will serve as Trainbearers to the King.)
- Princess/Prince
 - The couple bringing in the next highest amount of money in each grade will be the prince/princess of that grade. Princesses will receive flowers to carry.
- Maids and Escorts
 - All other participants will be maids and escorts

Grade 6 -

- Lord and Lady of Elementary School (formerly “Captains”)
 - The top money raising couple in the 6th grade will be Lord and Lady of the Elementary School.
- Princess/Prince
- The couple bringing in the next highest amount of money in the 6th grade will be the prince/princess of that grade. Princesses will receive flowers to carry.
- Maids and Escorts
 - All other participants will be maids and escorts.

POSITIONS OPEN FOR COMPETITION (Middle School)

This year the Middle School girls (7th and 8th grade) will be allowed to participate without an escort if they wish to enter the ball without a partner. An usher will be made available to escort any Middle School girls.

Grades 7-8 –

- Captains of Middle School (MINIMUM \$1000 fundraising)
 - The top money raising couple/girl will be the Captains of the Middle School.
- Maids and Escorts
 - All other participants will be Maids and Escorts or Maids.

(High School)

Grades 9-12 –

- King Victor and Queen Victoria (MINIMUM \$5000 fundraising)
 - The top money raising couple will be King Victor and Queen Victoria. ALL 9-12 COUPLES ARE ELIGIBLE TO BE KING AND QUEEN.

- Grand Duke and Grand Duchess (MINIMUM \$4000 fundraising)
 - The couple bringing in the second highest amount of money will be the Grand Duke and Grand Duchess.

A FUND-RAISING MINIMUM OF \$2000 IS REQUIRED TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A LADY IN WAITING POSITION

- First Lady in Waiting and Duke
 - The couple bringing in the third highest amount of money will be the First Lady in Waiting and Duke. The Lady will receive flowers.
- Second Lady in Waiting and Duke
 - The couple bringing in the fourth highest amount of money will be the Second Lady in Waiting and Duke. The Lady will receive flowers.
- Third Lady in Waiting and Duke
 - The couple bringing in the fifth highest amount of money will be the Third Lady in Waiting and Duke. The Lady will receive flowers.
- Fourth Lady in Waiting and Duke
 - The couple bringing in the sixth highest amount of money will be the Fourth Lady in Waiting and Duke. The Lady will receive flowers.

- Maids and Escorts
 - All other participants will be maids and escorts

HALL OF FAME

RESURRECTION CATHOLIC MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL:

RCMHS Hall of Fame is one of the highest honors a student may receive at Resurrection Catholic School. Hall of Fame inductees embody the spirit of Resurrection Catholic School. These students exemplify the following virtues: leadership, commitment, dependability, integrity, and scholarship. In addition, these students strive to excel in their academic pursuits.

REQUIREMENTS FOR HALL OF FAME INDUCTION:

- Leadership positions (extra points)
- Service
- Grades (honor roll points)
- Behavior (no infractions – or very few and minor)
- Involvement in campus life (clubs, activities, etc.)
- Carnival Ball participant at least once in middle school (for current 7,8, and 9 graders) and twice in high school (for ALL students). Students may earn a point per year that they participate in CB). For making court, students receive extra points.
- School attendance (no more than 15 days absent per year – grades 7-12)

RECOGNITION FOR HALL OF FAME:

- Photo displayed on Joseph Hall – FOREVER!!
- Photo on Hall of Fame page in yearbook
- Medal (not cord) at graduation (the Medal is large and BEAUTIFUL)
- Recognition on social media

CARNIVAL BALL AND HALL OF FAME:

Carnival Ball Participants automatically earn a point for each year they participate in carnival ball. For every year that participants raise over \$2,000, they may earn one extra point for each \$2,000. For example, if Participant “A” raises four thousand dollars, she earns three points – 1 point for participation, 1 point for \$2,000, and additional 1 point for \$2,000.

REMEMBER: You cannot be inducted in HALL OF FAME if you do not participate in Carnival Ball at least once in middle school (7 and 8) and twice in high school (9, 10, 11, 12). The exception to this rule is “new” students. If a student transfers to RCS during high school after ninth grade is complete, he or she may be permitted to only participate once in CB in high school.

HALL OF FAME RUBRIC:

Hall of Fame is determined through a point system (rubric). All of the above requirements, earn points. In addition, bonus points are added for leadership positions, awards (academic, Who’s Who, Virtue of the Month, Rotary Student of the Month, etc.), participation in leadership workshops – such as Trent Lott, HOBY, Singing River Electric Youth Forum, etc.), and activities like Mayor’s Youth Council.
