



“Bring a Friend to School” Day January 30-February 3, 2023

“Bring a Friend to School” is a new program for current RCS students in 3rd through 6th grades to invite potential students who are part of their sports teams, summer camps, churches, after-school programs, neighborhoods, etc., to spend a day with them at RCS. Students in Grades Pk-2nd that are interested in visiting this week should contact the office to set up a time to come.

To participate in this program:

- The week of January 30 to February 3, students may bring a friend to school for a day. The friend must currently be in the same grade as the RCS student.
- RCS parents should ask guest parents to complete the Permission Form by Friday, January 27th and turn it into the school office. Permission Forms will reserve a student's spot on a first-come, first-serve basis. Visiting students will be assigned one day during the week of January 30 to February 3.
- RCS students are only permitted to bring one friend. Visiting students must be genuinely interested in attending RCS.

On the day of the visit:

- Visiting students can travel to and from school with their RCS friend or can arrive separately and meet by the start of school. The elementary campus begins at 7:45 a.m. Guests should be picked up by their parents or their RCS friend's parents at the close of the school day at RCES.
- Your guest should bring his or her own lunch to school or they may get a tray in the cafeteria, our treat!
- Please note the guest's food allergies or medications on the Permission Form.
- Guest students must adhere to the policies and procedures of RCS, i.e., they must follow the RCS dress code (appropriate clothing), classroom behavior rules, etc. Appropriate clothing is expected. Jeans or athletic wear are acceptable for visiting students. Closed-toe shoes are required on both campuses.
