ASMC Educational Grant/Scholarship Program for 2023

1. The Mississippi Sound Chapter of the American Society of Military Comptrollers (ASMC) is pleased to announce the annual educational grant/scholarship program for high school students consisting of a \$500 scholarship award. The candidate must be a high school senior in the final half of his or her graduating year, and entering a financial management field of study, such as business administration, economics, accounting, or finance. If selected the winning candidate will compete for the ASMC National Scholarship.
2. Enclosed is the official educational grant/scholarship application and information on the national scholarship program. High school seniors must submit a signed letter of recommendation from their principal, counselor, or teacher. The letter of recommendation should be on school letterhead. If available, the applicants should include a copy of their college acceptance letter. All sections of the scholarship application must be completed except for the Nominator (Chapter President) Data.
3. Deadline for applying is 1 March 2023. Please e-mail complete packet to Ms. Sharon Floyd, Scholarship Committee Chair at [sharon.floyd.2@us.af.mil](mailto:sharon.floyd.2@us.af.mil). Applications will be judged by the Scholarship Committee. Winners will be notified and invited as guests of the chapter at the quarterly luncheon. Criteria for selection include scholastic achievements, leadership ability, extracurricular activities, and career and academic goals.
4. Winners will be given an endorsement letter from the ASMC Mississippi Sound Chapter President along with instructions for applying online for the national scholarship program.
5. More than one applicant from the same High School may apply.

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**Provide an essay of 250 words or less. Essay must address Career/Academic Goals and Financial Need. What do you want to accomplish? What circumstances prompt the need for financial support?**

## Objective

The objectives of the National Scholarship Program are to recognize graduating high school seniors for academic achievement, to provide financial assistance that they may accomplish their future financial management baccalaureate educational goals, and to increase local chapter scholarship programs.

## Award Criteria

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the final half of his/her school year, or a high school graduate within six months of the application deadline. Students that have won a national scholarship in previous years may qualify for continuing assistance.
- Applicant must be entering a field of study directly related to financial/resource management (such as business administration, economics, accounting, finance) Applications that do not fall within these fields will not be considered.

## Submission Requirements

- Application from high school applicants must have an ASMC chapter endorsement letter. Chapter presidents may submit up to two applications each award year. If a chapter submits more than two, the selection panel will review only the first two nominations received.
- Nomination must be submitted through the Awards Online website. No local chapter forms are accepted.
- High school applicants must have recommendation letter from an ASMC chapter president and an academic official, signed and dated.
- Applications from prior winners will require document support of a GPA of 3.0 or higher and a letter from the academic institution confirming continued work in the area of financial management.

## Award Selection Procedures

Applicant's scholastic achievements, leadership ability, extracurricular activities, career/academic goals and financial need will be considered. A selection panel, chaired by a member of the ASMC National Awards Committee, will review applications received and select award winners. Chapters will be notified by email in late May if their applicant has been selected as a winner.

Checks are mailed to the chapter in July, upon receipt of college acceptance letter by National Headquarters.

## Recognition

ASMC will award nine scholarships each year.

- One \$3,000 scholarship is awarded in honor of LTG James F. McCall, former Executive Director of ASMC. The recipient will demonstrate exemplary leadership abilities, clearly formed goals in the financial management career field, and academic promise. This winner may re-apply each year and receive \$1,500 for the following three academic years, if qualified.
- Four \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded. Recipients may re-apply each year to receive \$1,000 for the following three academic years, if qualified.
- Four \$1,000 scholarships will also be awarded. There will not be any follow on award after the initial award in this category.

Scholarships will be presented to the winning student(s) by the appropriate local ASMC chapter. Notification of college enrollment will be required before disbursement of the scholarship check(s) to the chapter. The award presentations and names of recipients may be publicized at chapter meetings, in newsletters, and at [www.asmconline.org](http://www.asmconline.org).

## Submission Deadline

The ASMC National Headquarters must receive applications between January 1 and March 31 to be considered by the selection panel. If March 31 falls on a weekend or federal holiday, the deadline will be the next business day. No exceptions to this deadline will be allowed. Any applications received incomplete or after this date will not be considered for selection. No applications by fax or e-mail transmission will be accepted.
